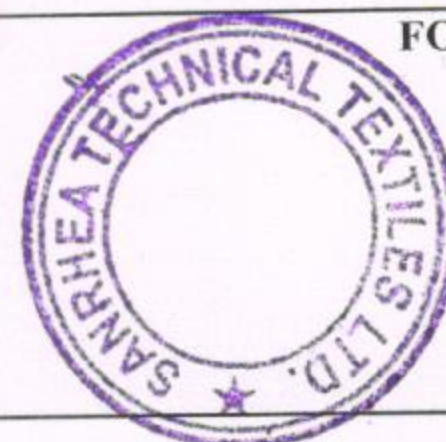

The figures have been regrouped wherever found necessary as per audited accounts. The statutory auditors of the company have carried out a independent audit report.
- b) The Auditors of the company had qualified the accounts / mentioned emphasis of the matter in the audit report for the Year 31.03.2016 which are addressed by the management by giving following clarifications.  
 (i) The Management is of the opinion that the diminution in value of long term quoted investments aggregating to ₹ 3.89 lakh is of temporary nature and do not represent the permanent fall in the value of individual investments.  
 (ii) Trade receivables over six months old amount to ₹ 38.18 lakh being pursued by the Company. In the opinion of the management they are considered as good and fully receivable.
- c) The company is having business in one segment only i.e. Industrial Fabrics, hence segment reporting as defined in Accounting standard 17 is not applicable.
- d) The figures of the previous year/ quarter have been regrouped/ rearranged to be in conformity with current years figure

## LIMITED REVIEW REPORT

### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of **Sanrhea Technical Textiles Ltd** (the 'Company'), for the Quarter and Nine months ended 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2016 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Accounting Standards for Interim Financial Reporting (AS 25), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

### Scope of Review

We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

### Basis for Qualified Conclusion

The Company has made long term investment in quoted equity shares for which market value/book value is not available. In accordance with the Accounting Standard referred to in section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, where there is decline other than temporary, in the carrying amount of long term investments, the resultant deduction in the carrying amount require provision to statement of Profit and Loss. In our opinion amount of ₹ 3.89 lakhs for diminution in value of long term quoted investments requires provision of identical amount (Refer note b (i)).

We further report that had the observations made by us in above paragraph been considered, the Profit for the quarter would have been decreased by ₹ 3.89 lakhs and non-current Investments would have been decreased by same figure.



**Emphasis of Matter**

Attention is invited to Note no. b (ii) of the financial results, where in as per the reasons stated by the management, trade receivables of ₹ 38.18 lakhs outstanding at the nine months end as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2016 are considered realisable/ recoverable.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of the above matters

**Qualified Conclusion**

Based on our review conducted as stated above, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the aforesaid Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
